THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Colin G. Bell, Esq., of Hankin, Palladino, Weintrob, Bell & Labov, P.C., attorneys for Defendant Barbara Murphy-Leary a/k/a Barbara Leary ("Leary"), seeking relief by way of order to show pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Public Expression Protection Act, N.J.S.A. 2A:53A-49 et seq, and the Court having issued an order to show cause pursuant to that statute directing Plaintiff Gary DeMarzo to show cause why his claims against Leary should not be dismissed with prejudice; and DeMarzo have subsequently dismissed all claims against Leary with prejudice, and the Leary having thereafter submitted an application for an award of

attorney's fees and costs; and the Court having considered the papers and arguments of counsel; and for good cause having been shown,

IT IS ON THIS 15th day of APRIL, 2025, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:


1. Leary is the prevailing party in this matter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:53A-55(c) and therefore entitled to recover reasonable court costs, attorney's fees, and litigation expenses from Plaintiff Gary DeMarzo pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:53A-58.

2. Leary is entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees of ~~\$8,160~~ ^{\$5,985.00} and court costs and expenses of \$423.39 from DeMarzo.

3. Pursuant to Rule 4:42-2(a), this order adjudicates all rights and liabilities related to Leary in this action and it would be unjust to delay her right to enforce it.

4. Therefore, final judgment is entered in favor of Defendant Barbara Murphy-Leary a/k/a Barbara Leary and against Plaintiff Gary DeMarzo in the total amount of ~~\$8,583.39~~ \$6,408.39.

5. This Order or Judgment shall be deemed automatically served upon all counsel of record simultaneously with its online posting in eCourts; otherwise, all other parties shall be served by the party obtaining this Order or Judgment within seven (7) days of its entry. See Rule 1:5-1(a).
